Several years ago (2005) I grew frustrated with the instruments I was using to do team building, staff development, leadership team retreats, and Leadership Coaching. I love the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator, but found that few teams or individuals grasped the prolific information required for understanding the MBTI well enough to use it. After leading a few retreats with the MBTI, I looked for another approach. Simultaneously, I took a Practicum course in Executive Coaching in my Coach Training Program. Mike Lillibridge led this Practicum, introducing us to The Peoplemap through the course. After using The Peoplemap to coach two Executives forward, I was quickly convinced that The Peoplemap was the instrument I was looking for. I was already equipped and trained to give the Emotional Intelligence Inventory, coaching others forward based on the EI competencies. But the EI is about competencies, rather than personality. The Peoplemap became the perfect complement to what I was already doing. I found it to be accurate, simple, easily understood, and most importantly – readily applied to real life and work. Since then, The Peoplemap has become a major part of my training and coaching with many individuals and groups.

After requests from professionals and lay persons from various fields and walks of life to become trainers, I approached Mike Lillibridge about training up a crew. He was open to the idea, and I took a group to Florida to be trained as Peoplemap Trainers.

Since then I have continued to develop my Peoplemap practice, including a close and ongoing relationship with the Peoplemap author. Now Mike Lillibridge has made me a trainer – one who can train others to become Certified Peoplemap Trainers. Until recently, only Dr. Lillibridge could train new trainers. Now he has made me the first Peoplemap Trainer who can train-the-trainer.

About The Peoplemap System

The PeopleMap™ System is an integrated series of interpersonal effectiveness training programs that teach people how to communicate and relate to each other more effectively through an understanding of their own and others' personality types. The skills learned can be applied to enhance both professional and personal relationships.

The foundation for the PeopleMap™ System is the PeopleMap™ Questionnaire, which is unique in that it includes only **seven questions**, takes five minutes to complete and self-score and has a 95% accuracy rate in determining the person's primary and secondary personality types.



Using the information from the PeopleMap™ Questionnaire, participants learn about their primary and secondary personality types and how they impact their values, needs, and world view. They also learn about the personality types of others and how to effectively communicate with all personality types. In addition to learning about the in-born strengths of each type, participants gain an understanding of the "Achilles Heel," and learn how to incorporate new behaviors into their day to day lives to increase their professional success.

Originally developed to help couples improve their communication and relationships, the PeopleMapTM System is used to transform ordinary communication into extraordinary results by enhancing authentic working relationships at all levels of the organization so that everyone works together using a common, unified language.

The Peoplemap System Training Programs

1. Understanding Yourself and Others

This is the foundational program upon which all of the other PeopleMap™ programs are based. Participants learn that each personality type has three in-born strengths that help them succeed in their work, relationships and personal life, as well as an Achilles Heel. When understood, the Achilles Heel can be turned into a *"learned"* strength. Therefore, each personality type learns the specific areas that they need to address in their own growth and development so they can perform at their highest level.

2. Understanding and Relating to Communication Preferences

Each personality type typically wants to be understood and related to in a specific manner. Participants learn how to talk others' " $PeopleMap^{TM}$ Language" to enhance communication, solve problems and work together more successfully.

3. Leadership Teambuilding

This program teaches the eight core competencies of Leadership and Teams to participants, believing that both need the same skill set to be successful with each other and for the success of their organization.

All of the PeopleMap™ System programs include books, workbooks and support materials.
